Code of Conduct

TEENS ENCOUNTER CHRIST is a peer ministry for Senior High aged through first year post high school youth. Weekends are comprised of both adults and youth. There are opportunities as well as responsibilities on a T.E.C. weekend. Both team members and weekenders are required to follow the guidelines and standards set forth by the T.E.C. Council. The T.E.C. Council will expect appropriate conduct from youth and adults when present at events.

Inappropriate Conduct Includes:

- Consumption or misuse of chemicals, i.e. alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs. (Adults of legal age are allowed to smoke in designated areas using discretion.) § 609.681, 609.685(3), 340A.503(1)(3)
- Possession or sale of illegal drugs, or misuse of prescribed drugs § 152
- Neglecting to provide adequate health and safety measures, care, and supervision.
- Abusive verbal or physical behavior toward weekenders or team members. § 609.72
- Sexual advances or sexual activity of any kind between weekenders and/or team members. Includes inappropriate behavior, unwanted contact, exhibitionism, or involvement in pornographic activities or materials.
- Representing an event as sponsored by T.E.C. when it has not received T.E.C. Council approval. Social events where there are people from the T.E.C. community present does not constitute a T.E.C. sanctioned event.
- Promoting an ideology or religious view contrary to Christian teachings.
- Promoting an individual philosophy inconsistent with T.E.C.'s philosophy while serving as a T.E.C. representative.
