

## **Beyond TEC**

### **Pray about what God wants you to say in this talk**

- A.
1. Given by the Co-Directors as the last talk of the weekend.
  2. The talk should be about 10 minutes in length for each person.
  3. Choose an appropriate song for the talk.
  4. Suggested bible verses; Matthew 17: 1-13, Philippians 1: 3-6 & 9-11.
- B.
1. This talk should sum up elements of all the weekend talks and show the weekenders how to use what they have learned after their TEC weekend ends.
- C.
1. Talk about the highlights you have seen throughout the weekend.
  2. Share your personal encounter with Christ.
  3. Share YOUR Beyond TEC experience.
  4. Share how important it is to Encounter Christ everyday. (Not just on Sundays, holidays or at TEC)
  5. Remind the weekenders that it is not easy to live your life for Christ daily. We all falter (Did you?). But Christ is there, waiting for us.
  6. It is our hope and prayer that whatever you may have discovered this weekend that you take it home with you. Embrace it. Make it a part of who you are. Share it with others.
- D.
1. Share some TEC ideals.
    - a. Talk about your TEC experience. Never say that TEC has secrets, consider them gifts. We did not tell you about them because we wanted you to enjoy the experience of opening your own 'gift'.
    - b. Do not make TEC your church. Get involved with your church or find one. You cannot "be fed" only twice a year and have your faith grow.
    - c. We encourage you to come back and work on a TEC team.
    - d. Encourage your friends to 'Encounter Christ' on a future TEC weekend.
- E.
1. Challenge the weekenders to not let their weekend to be an ending but rather a beginning.
  2. Remind them that Christ wanted to be a part of their lives so much that He died for them/us.
