- A.
1. Your talk is right after God is Love on Rise day.
 2. The talk should be about 15 minutes long.
 3. Pick an appropriate song for your talk
 4. Some suggested Bible readings are: I Corinthians 12, Acts 2: 42-47. Matthew 16:18, I Peter 2:9.
- B.
1. This talk is aimed at showing the weekenders the importance of belonging to a church.
 2. Each table is named after a community where Paul started a church.
 3. Church is at the heart of Christian growth. (Just as you sharpen your sports skills by practicing with a team, so you keep sharp in your faith by regular worship)
 4. We are called by Christ to live our lives as He has shown us for Him. You need to be around others who share your faith for it to grow.
- C.
1. How has your church influenced your life?
 2. Why do you or others you know go to your church?
 3. What do you do to stay active in your church? (Be careful here not to go too far into Christians Called to Action)
 4. Is your life any different with from your church friends than away from them?
- D.
1. Encourage weekenders who do not have a church to find one.
 2. A Church is not a building or organization. It is the people.
 3. TEC cannot be your church. You must be fed more than 2-4 times a year to grow.
 4. Challenge the weekenders to look at their own involvement in their churches.
 5. Urge them to worship regularly.
