- A.
1. This talk is given on “Go Forth Day” (Monday) just before table commissioning begins.
 2. The talk should be about 15 minutes in length.
 3. Pick a song appropriate to your talk.
 4. Suggested bible verses, John 15: 1-8, Matthew 25: 31-46, James 2: 14-17
- B.
1. This talk is built on the concept of “Just do it!”
 2. Show how becoming a witness for Christ is doable.
 3. This talk nicely sums up the previous two talks of Communications and Christians in the Community. It is our call to ACT on these ideas.
- C.
1. The world is a broken place with many needs. (This is a phenomenon that has been around since long before Jesus)
 2. How have you witnessed this brokenness?
 3. Our JOB as Christians is to show Christ to the world we live in.
 4. We cannot all be Mother Theresa, pastors, or missionaries, but there is much we can do.
 5. What are some practical things that can be done? (A smile, be a friend to someone in need, volunteering your time and talent, mission trips etc.)
 6. What have you done?
 7. How does it feel to serve?
 8. Evangelism is NOT about standing on a soapbox preaching to the world. It IS about going out into the world and showing Christ’s love. “Be Jesus with skin on”.
- D.
1. Challenge the weekenders to get out of their comfort zones and be a witness for Christ. (Give examples)
 2. Show Christ in all they do. Walk the walk and talk the talk.
 3. To fulfill Christ’s command to “love on another”.
