Pray about what God wants you to say in this talk.

- A.
1. Your talk immediately follows 'Who am I' and will be the second talk given on 'Die Day'.
 2. Your talk should be about 15 minutes long.
 3. Pick an appropriate song for your talk.
 4. Think of this talk as a love letter from a Father who wants only the best for you in your life (the Bible).
- B.
1. Some suggestions for scripture readings: John 1:1-14, I Timothy 4:11-14, II Timothy 3:16.
 2. These are only suggested verses. **Your talk should be very personal and reflect what the bible means to you.**
 3. **What are your favorite verses? How do you use it?**
- C.
1. The Bible is Gods gift to us (and our gift to the weekenders).
 2. The Bible is Gods message to us. It is a message of hope, love, sacrifice, promise, our history and where we are going.
 3. God speaks to us through the passages written in the Bible.
 - a. Gods message is as meaningful today as it was 2000 years ago.
- D.
2. Our purpose as Christians is to live our lives for God.
 - a. His instructions on how we are to live our lives as Christians are in the Bible.
 - b. By reading the Bible we better understand God and His plan for us. How He wants to have a relationship with us.
- E.
1. Most Christian homes have a Bible, but it is only a decorative piece.
 2. How do YOU use your Bible?
 3. It should be used. Take it with you and READ it.
 - a. It's a great resource when you need help (look in the back of the book).
 - b. It also contains everything that make up a great novel (love, war, greed, lust, humor and a great ending.)
 4. It is not necessary to read it cover to cover. But the more you read the more comfortable it gets.
- F. Your song should reflect the Word of God. It can be about the Bible as a whole or aimed at a particular verse, meaningful to you. Explain why you chose your song.
