1. Introduce yourself (age, school, grade etc.)
 2. How do you see yourself? How do others? Share some personal experiences.
 3. High school years are a time of discovery and searching for our own identity. Often apart from our family and friends.
 4. This is a time of great change and often crisis.
 5. Things may not always work out the way we want them to and then we have to start all over again.

1. The things that affect who we are:
 - a. Love
 - b. Relationships with family, friends, etc.
 - c. School
 - d. Our Faith
 2. Things that we often fill our lives with that we think make up who we are. The six P's.
 - a. Popularity
 - b. Personal appearance (hair, clothes etc.)
 - c. Possessions
 - d. Performance (sports, clubs etc)
 - e. Power
 - f. Pleasure
- D.
1. God has a plan for each of us. Are we asking Him to help us.
 2. We can find 'meaning' in living our lives for Christ.
 3. No matter how scary life may be, Jesus can pull us through.

1. Challenge the weekenders to look closely at who they are and the direction they are heading.
