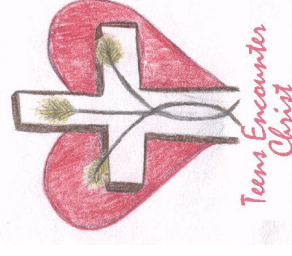

What is T.E.C.?

T.E.C. is a peer ministry aimed at helping teenagers spend a few days immersed in God's love. During this time, you will hear talks, two given by clergy and seven given by other youth who have previously attended T.E.C. These talks are geared towards sharing a personal perspective on how we experience God in daily life.

Along with these talks, you will encounter prayer, worship, singing, food, sharing, fun, fellowship and other activities which promote the idea that God truly does love us!



What Are the Details?

T.E.C. weekends run from Friday evening through a Sunday evening. You bring your sleeping bag and stay overnight at the host church. Cost is \$40.

Youth attending the weekend come from all over the Twin Cities. Congregations can usually send 3-6 youth per T.E.C. weekend. Those who have attended T.E.C. can also work the retreat as volunteers.
